

Idaho River 20 Nov. 1871

Hon. A. W. Touge
Dear Sir

Your favour is to hand - I never heard
Gen Littlefield say one word as to the terms or conditions
upon which he loaned you or let you have that
thirty five hundred dollars or any other sum whatsoever,
He has never transferred to me your notes or said
anything to me about them in any way. I did not
know you gave him any note whatever.

I will see Gen L soon and will if I can ascertain
to whom he passed your notes and if it was done
before any attachment was served on you. I have
but little doubt he has long ago passed them
off. I wish you would arrange for me to see
you soon. I shall go to N York the latter part
of this week and will probably remain 8 or 10
days soon after my return I shall go to
Florida. wish to see you before I go. will write
you from N York and let you know what time
I will pass through Greensboro so you can
see me there
