with other evil disposed persons confederate
did on the 20th day of August 1869
feloniously kill and murder one certain
colored man named Morrow, whose Christian
name is unknown to Affiant -

There are therefore to command you forthwith
to apprehend the said Franklin Faucett, Sam. W. Gurrard, Sam-
uel Nevels, Manly Emdrey, Jno. Durham (of Alvis),
Jno. Durham (of Mebane) and Tho^o Emdrey and them
have before me at Chambers in Graham to answer
said charge, and be further dealt with according to law,
as above stated - Albion W. Torgue Judge Sup^r Court
