- David R. Love being first duly sworn says:
- I belonged to the White Brotherhood in Alamance County
- + I was first on a raid on Daniel Jordan. I have heard the statement of William Love as to this raid and agree with him in regard to it.
- + I have also heard his statement as to the raid on W. S. Long and agree with him in that.
- + ~~Also~~ <sup>Also</sup> that on Abner at Peter Arizoners and agree as to that.
- + Also that on Norfolk Malone and agree as to that.
- + I was also on a raid upon a negro man living at Robert Thomas - named Lewis - Jacob Boone, Alon Boone, William Cobb, Rankin Cummins, were along. We were in disguise. We whipped - a right good little whipping.
- + + The next raid was at the Green Yard. - David Thomas, William Serringer, Tubane <sup>Engle</sup> ~~Engle~~, Gingles <sup>Engle</sup> ~~Engle, Jacob Boone jr., Alon Boone, Rod, Sheppard, Sam. Somers, Tubane Apple, <sup>Boone</sup> ~~Boone~~ and James M. Sutton dep. Shiff had the negro in custody - The negro's name was Sam. Smith - Tubane Apple and <sup>Sam.</sup> Somers were not members of the Klan - Sutton's home own away, Sutton + ~~Boone~~ Boone were members - and further affiant saith not.~~
