- 1 That this is an action for a money demand.
  - 2 That service of process on me was duly made by publication, and the complaint was filed at the return term, Fall Term 1870, within the first three days thereof, duly return to.
  - 3 That defendant entered an appearance by their Atty.
  - 4 That plaintiff's Atty extended to defendant's Atty as time in which to file an answer, until March 4<sup>th</sup> 1871.
  - 5 That no copy of complaint was furnished defendant until requested by the latter in April 1871
  - 6 That defendant did not file an answer within the time given by plaintiff.
  - 7 That defendant's Atty received from defendant an answer to the complaint after the adjournment of the Court at Spring Term 1871, but during the term.
  - 8 That no copy of the answer was received by defendant's Atty for the use of plaintiff
  - 9 That defendants are non-residents
