My dear Sir

Hoping that your domestic affairs - the health of your child - will make this no intrusion, I beg to say:

That in all probability I shall not be in Illinois next week: I have asked Mr Webb to draw a judgment in *Hogson v Thibault* & submit to your Honor. In the case of the Trustees of University v W.D. Jones & Wm. High I have sent Mr Shegerson a judgment with an order awarding: this by arrangement with W.D. Jones one of the defendants.

What I wished to say particularly is, that in a case of Sei Fa upon a bail bond in *Case vs W.W. Holden, Budget &c*, I wish to ask judgment of your Honor a Sei Fa is the proper remedy. A Sei Fa upon a bail bond in a criminal case is a civil remedy; the suit is a civil suit. I wished to submit that it should be brought by summons & complaint.

If your Honor has not already sentence
held, I wish this point made. It seems
to me worthy of consideration - and a good
enough "demonstration" at all events to justify
that the case be sent? - especially as
Baker B. is not a bloody minded man.

I am however serious in making this
objection. Please show this to Baker B.
