

Goldboro N. C. Jun 8th 1873

My dear wife: Your letter of yesterday
and the outline were received today - I
am having a most busy time this week
than before - Have just concluded a big
furnace case today which occupied two
days - I am tired and don't feel very
well at best - I will try and write
you some more in the morning before
work - If I have not time I will just
send this and you must make it pass
for a letter - Yours Albion -
