Mr. Mahon sends the order to crane to  
 them with the goods of mine in commission, to you - by this mail -  
 We enclose a statement of them also which will require some explanation  
 the fresh & items are goods consigned to them - as which they are to have  
 10% of commission for selling - and to be allowed a margin of 20% to  
 sell on - that is - they were to sell at bid price if possible but could they not  
 get that price were allowed to give 10% to their customers - but if any sales  
 were made at better price than 20% - they were to give no credit - the next item  
 is \$40 - net - from which they are to have no discount or to have no commission  
 as it is sold to them at special discount there 20% - the next of them  
 are their credits - and to furnish me - the next one July 19<sup>th</sup> is \$10000 bill  
 less - and leave me - the next one \$10000 is the net out of a sale made  
 to Mr. Mahon - their net advancements you will see are \$76.00 -  
 Our commissions are \$275.00 - and on \$2038.00 of that they are to have  
 10% commission and to be allowed what was discount they had to give their  
 trade - I think from the above explanation that you will
