 We have measured the lumber very liberally and
 find on one car 6345 fb. - the other 5328 fb.
 making a total of 11673 fb. - which amount we
 have credited you and enclose note for the amount
 less the fb charges. The first lot of lumber
 will all correct. - but you or whoever measured the
 last lot have probably made an error. We find
 on examining this lumber that a large br. ch. is
 only half inch thick - which is almost useless to us.
 You must be particular about the thickness - do not
 think we are chivalrous fools. - Give us what we ask for
 and you will find us in thick as pleasant customers
 as you have, but we are not going to take lumber that
