I could not write you on yesterday as no mail went up last night. I staid in my own room all day - asleep most of the time and wishing I was at home the rest of it - I tried to read some, sleep much and wrote a little. I feel bound to stay here as there are a few of our men who are ready on such matters and whom our folks will follow. You will get the Constitution every morning now so that you will know what is going on without the daily bulletins from me. I send you the copy right act they sent me. It is very discouraging but all must come out right some time - The Democrats do not seem to have fully developed their plans yet but to be trying to agree upon what they will do -
