Dear Husband.

I meant to have written
you a letter yesterday but I did not have
time before I went to Mrs Keoghs and it was
nine o'clock before we got back so the day
slipped away and you got no letter, but I
thought of you often.

My cook has disappointed me, some of her
family being very sick, and as I hoped to
get her soon I thought I would get no one
until she could come. Mr Parkinson
will be here tonight and if your friend
comes up with you tomorrow night I must
fix up the other room and I will try
and get some one to help me over Sunday
as I would not like to be in the kitchen

all the time. Would you send me a telegram if you decide to come as I can make arrangements as early as you can? If I get news I will expect you to come alone.

I am glad you have heard from Howard and shall expect to see the letter in the morning - Certainly \$200. is a good deal better than nothing and we ought not to complain though twice as much would have been none too much it seems to me.

We had a very pleasant day yesterday Lodie especially enjoyed it immensely. I see by the Patriot that Durham had written that the Convention would likely adjourn on the 4th Oct. or the 10th at the farthest. The Dem. are getting a little tired of their game after all it seems. Well the sooner the better. I am going down to take this to the office myself and as it looks like rain I must hurry off - I shall hope to see you soon -
