Enclosed I beg to hand you copy of judgement roll in case of Commissioners of Granville vs Jas. S. Moore and others. Our counsel Mr Horsfall is of opinion that our then counsel Peace & Young had no right to take judgement for a less sum than the amount named in the complaint without the consent of the Board, it being a judgement Nil dicet. And he also says that he is doubtfull as to whether the Board has the power to take from a Sheriff's sureties a less sum than is really due by a defaulting Sheriff. There is another debt of \$1500.⁰⁰ for licenses, merchants returns of sales &c in the office of the Register of Deeds which has only just come to light, and is not included in this action. There is also a debt owing to the State Treasurer from the same source of about \$2500.⁰⁰ Mr H. is of opinion that we can commence an action for
