ing.

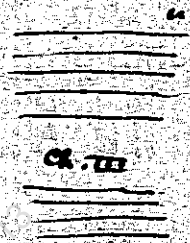

If you break ~~the~~ Chapter II.

(formerly, Chap. III) into two Chapters,
so as to save re-numbering the
Chapters, it will be necessary to let
Chap. III (as marked in) commence in
the middle of the page, thus:



This will be a little irregular, as the
other Chapters begin at the top of the
pages - but it will be better than
re-numbering the fifty-odd Chapters.
[It would not do to try to make Chap.
III begin with a page; for it would
be necessary not only to write in
something to bring the chapter-opening
up higher, but also to re-fold the whole
book again. This, however, I think you
do not contemplate.] I will go ahead
then and simply insert "Chapter III" in
the middle of that page.

You have marked on pp. 27 & 29 two cross-
reference, showing the use of the same phrase
twice - ("individuals do not cause events to come to
pass; or something like that) but you did not change
either of them. Shall I do so?
