Literary Note.

SINCE the days of "A Fool's Errand," "Bricks Without Straw," and that whole series of extraordinary novels laid amid scenes of slavery, war and reconstruction. Judge Tourgee has not attempted much fiction, confining himself to journalistic work and lecturing. But he has sent out several clever things with such touches of his characteristic power as show that the "wonted fires" are only covered, not out.
