Dear Mrs. Tourgee,

We do not know how the Judge feels about those matters. It is a good engagement, and the distance is not very great. He must be at Shenandoah, Va. at 6 o'clock in the morning. He can drive it in about an hour and 20 minutes, at least in two hours. He is at Kansas City Mo. the night previous to College Springs, and we want to place the 2nd of Feb. at Minden Neb.

Will write you in a couple of days regarding the California trip. Have changed Evanston, Ill. to Jan. 24th, which was formerly Jan. 18th. The Judge's dates therefore stand now for Jan. as follows,— Lake Linden, Mich. Jan. 12th, Ishpeming, Mich. the 14th Escanaba, Mich. the 15th, Marquette the 16th, Janesville, Wis. the 21st; Belvidere, Ill. the 22nd, Berlin, Wis. the 23rd, and Evanston, Ill. the 24th. We have other towns offered, but no acceptance up to date. Have 14 dates filled for Feb.
