My Darling: I laid abed and dozed
and sucked sugar and whiskey after
reaching here yesterday until
time for the lecture. Got through
with only one or two hauls
and am much better this
morning - that is, I think I
am - my head is so stuffed
up with quinine that I can't
tell how I am till about
dark. I leave for Chicago
at 11.21. and shall give
my entire attention to get-
ting over it so as to speak

with comfort at Evanston.
I think yesterday broke its
back. The weather is delight-
ful.

I shall get the ten o'clock
train in from Evanston
and go right across to
the Lake Shore Depot and
take the 11.30 East.
This will get me to Beren-
ton about 7 p.m.
