I am hard at work

and can only stop to write a word.
I got home at 4 o'clock yesterday. Had a good
night's rest and have worked all day.

Deposited \$200. There was notice that
a check was overdrawn \$38 and check to Clayton
protested. You must stop drawing checks
in advance of deposits. There is now
no need for it. Instead of trying to do
everything at once you must look ahead,
calculate what you will need, pay part
of bills instead of all and not give checks
in excess of deposit. If you do not do
first you know your account will be
flying out.

From present indications — a
light rain and warm, — with fore-
cast of still warmer in the future —
I shall probably stay until Monday
morning. If it storms tomorrow
however, I shall go tomorrow
night.
