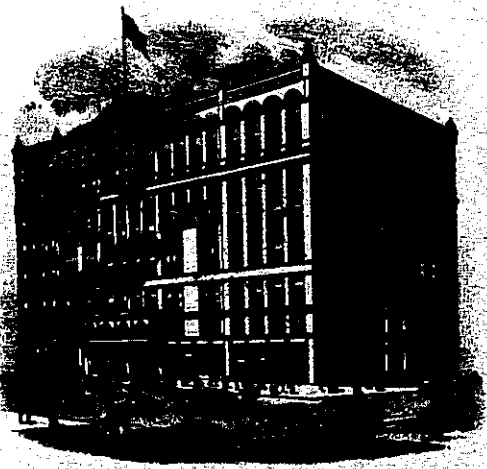


Kansas City Feb 24 1889

My Dear:

I have written my By-stander and mailed it; read the papers; lunched a little; eaten lunch and now must write some telegrams, a letter to you a note to sis and then I think I will go to Church - just for a rarity.

Barring the coldness of the rooms this is a splendid house nice rooms, beds, etc, and dining-rooms and kitchen on the 7th floor overlooking the whole city. The city itself you would hardly know from what you saw of it 7 years ago. It is a wonder no question about that. I have had a very quiet day as nobody is able



to send my name on the register
or else does not know who I am,
I have just been looking up my dates
and find the Pottersville and Canton
dates 15-16 ^{were} impossible. They cannot be
made from Cedar Falls by any possible
route. So I shall go home 9 a.m. the
15th and stay until 3 a.m. the 19th unless
I leave at 5 p.m. the 18th. You will of
course meet me at Ottumwa, why not
come to Williamsport and go across with me
and then back to Carlisle with me. I don't
know what comes after that but probably
Pottersville and Canton. I may get a
letter from you here tomorrow morning
forwarded from Omaha but do not ex-
pect it.

Will send you some more money
as soon as I can get to a bank where

It is open, possibly tomorrow, but
that is doubtful as I leave here at 9.40
and arrive at Columbus at 2.40.
