and not "foreign" was

"impurity" and not
"inparity". In the third
case the word is very
obscure. It is not "are"
and it is not "were",

called it "are."

I will have changes made in the plates in all three of these instances, so that future editions may be correct.

The word "northern" appears in several other connections. If it is wrong in any other, will you please advise me.
