My dear son yours of the 9<sup>th</sup>  
is just brought in and I sit  
down to reply I was receiving  
the news here for me as I had  
been getting more than  
common for me and it was  
like a life saver to me  
and I had a bit but very  
little for two nights I now see  
where I made the mistake in not  
writing at once that it was all  
right but when you wrote you  
would send me \$50. I set down  
perfectly satisfied the matter  
will answer my turn at the times  
mentioned to wit \$50 on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of 50.

\$50. on the 23 and \$25 on the 25<sup>th</sup>

I never before saw the time  
I could not go out and pick up  
\$100. in a short time two seasons  
block the way now one is I  
should not know where to go for it  
another is I could not go for it  
if I did. but I am resolved  
no one shall loose one dollar ~~from~~  
by me. let fortune go as it may  
with me one thing rather surp-  
-rises me if we have worked ciling  
through the Roena and myself  
and have not run behind one  
cent though milking only one  
Farrow cow and several hogs  
though furnishing flour & Land  
wood for two fires Potatoes  
~~and~~ meat Butter and milk for 4  
and got along bravely and I feel  
greatly encouraged and lights  
burning <sup>all</sup> night but my  
writing does not look very  
good so I will fix it to send of  
in the morning God Bless you  
my son and your poor old Father
