A national salute will be fired from the Point on the arrival of Corporal Tanner about noon, Saturday. Frequent salvos of artillery will make the groves of Chautauqua ring with the music of '61--'65.

Ample accommodations for all will be provided at the low rate of \$1 per day or 25 cents per meal or lodging. Any wishing to do so will be welcome to remain on the grounds till Monday morning. The management grants the veterans the free use of a building for committee and other business meetings while on the ground.
