In reply to yours of Oct. 23th would say that we have been doing our best to secure engagements for the Judge, but you must remember that this Western country opens much later than the Eastern business. Have postponed the Judge's date at Muskegon, Mich. to about Nov. 29th or 30th. He is booked at Neenah, Wis. for Dec. 3rd, Jacksonville, Ill. Dec. 6th; Pawnee City, Neb. Dec. 9th, Sioux Falls, Dak. Dec. 16th, and at Des Moines, Ia. Dec. 19th, and at Washington, Ill. Dec. 5th. We expect to make a number of other engagements to connect with these, and I have no doubt but what his time will be well filled.
