To reach Sandwich, Ill. from Elgin, leave Elgin at 11.52 A.M. and arrive at Chicago at 2.40 P.M. Then take the C.R. & Q.R.R. the next day at 12 noon, and get to Sandwich at 1.54, or you can leave here at 4.20 P.M. and arrive at Sandwich, at 6.27
