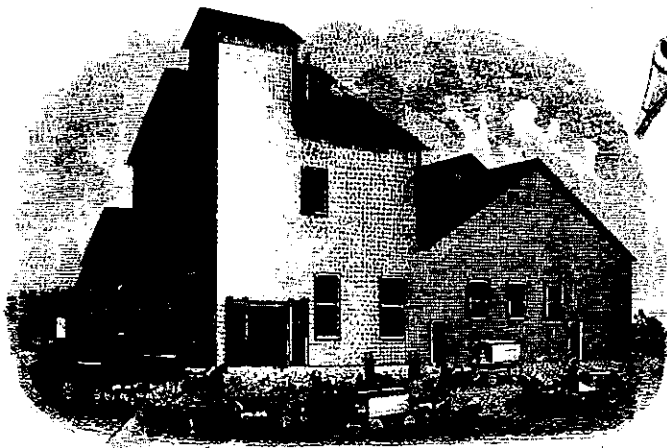

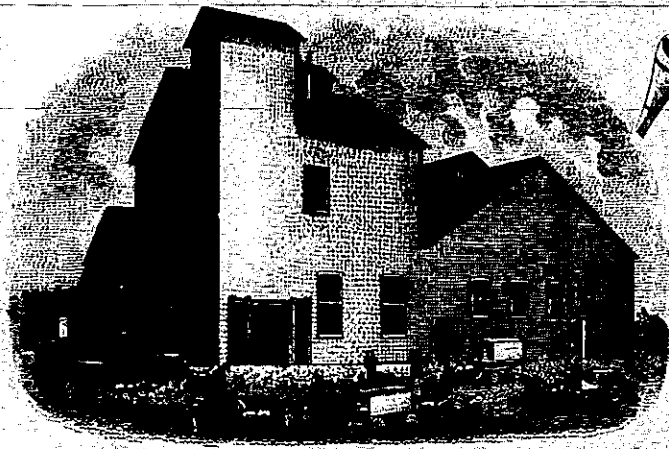
My Dear Sir -
