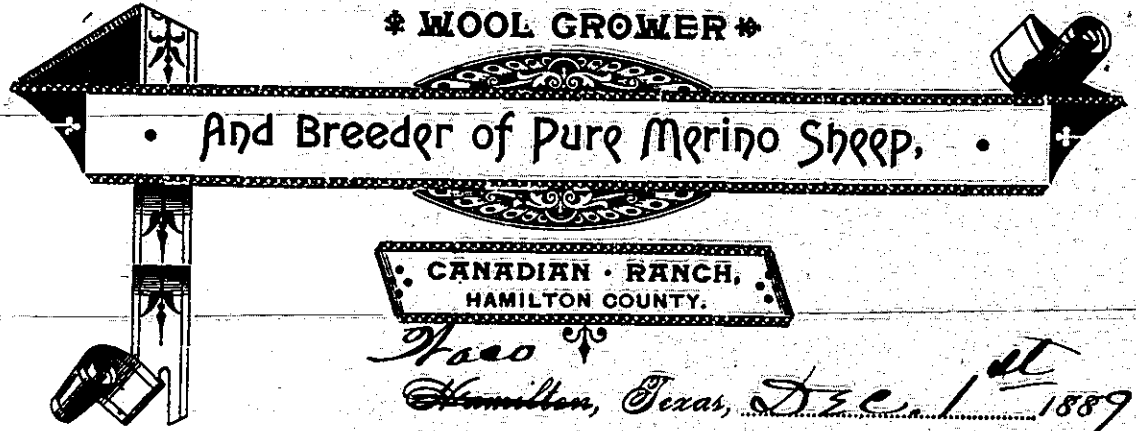

Dear Sir

I herewith send you a copy of the Haco Day containing a proposition for the solution of the race problem by Chas J. C. Picette Esq of the Day staff and ask that it be made the subject of the Bystander's notes in the Inter Ocean I acknowledge allegiance to Republican principles having espoused them in 1860 and held them to this hour, and yet the policy which lifted at one bound 5,000,000 of people from a condition of slavery with all its inherent evil and degradation to one of full fledged citizenship with its high duties and responsibilities 20 years ago seemed to me then one of doubtful expediency and the unwisdom of that policy is even more apparent now after a residence of 13 years
