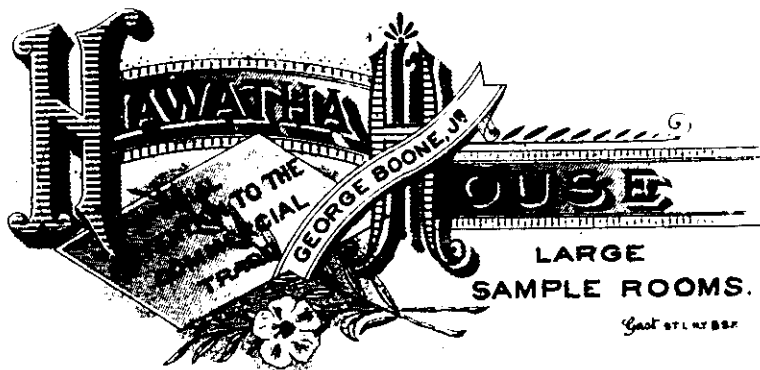
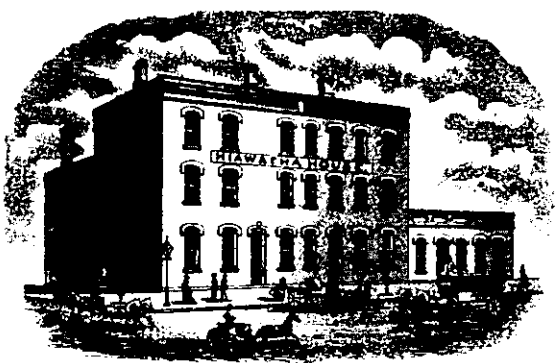


Siwatha, Kans. Dec 17 1889
