Regarding copyright notice
I do not think it would be
wise to use the 1888 copyright
notice for should we do this
it would make it appear as
a new edition only of an
old book. It should be re-
copyrighted in 1890.

There is no objection

to copyrighting in England
excepting that it will cause
a delay of about two weeks
in the publication of the book.

Nor is there any objection
to publishing a list of your
other books. It will make a
neat page and we will fix
it up for you as you desire.

It would also be all
right to insert a page as
Publishers Preface. Do I under-
stand that the page you send
us is to be used for that
purpose including the list of

books instead of having a
separate list and facing
title page?
