her lesson - and was going to the office a little late. Well - I trust you received it safe any way - but thought I would write a line today. Two of Post Card's were at the post office were in to get orders they had given me I saw it - and each card said "just like it." They were to be sent to Washington. Philadelphie & N.Y. A friend of mine for many years Cala - visited me last week - she is reading "The White Christ" and is delighted. She writes stories for small day newspapers and some very nice poetry. Mattice L. Woodward is her name. It is a beautiful day - my Crocuses are all in bloom. I put 300 bulbs in the ground in Nov. and I will have at least 1000 flowers from them.
