of the 105th Reg't of Inftry Ohio Vol. -
and in reference to Alonzo Chubb who served as
2^d Lieut. of S. Company - said 105th Reg't, he declares as follows.

My Post Office Address is -

I well remember said Chubb. - When he joined
the company in the Summer of 1862. - I think he was a
sound healthy man. - Said Chubb was captured by
the enemy near Murfreesborough Tenn. - some time
about 20th January 1863. - I think he was in sound health
when so captured. He rejoined the company at Murfreesborough
sometime in the month of May 1863. - He was then badly
afflicted with chronic Diarrhoea. - which he had con-
tracted while in prison and from which he continued
to suffer in a greater or less degree afterwards while he
remained in the service. Said Chubb while with his company
in battle of Chucamunga Ga. - 19th Sept. 1863 was wounded
by what was supposed to be a pistol ball, which struck
him in neck on left side. - From disability from chronic
Diarrhoea and from this wound tendered his resignation
and was discharged in Oct. 1863. - I was present with
the ~~company~~ ^{detachment} when he was captured by the enemy ^{with the regiment} also when
he rejoined the regiment. and when he was wounded
and knew personally of the facts as above recited. -

that as far as he ever knew, and as he believes, said Chubb

did not induce, aggravate, increase or prolong his disabilities by intemperance or other bad habits, and

that affiant has no interest whatever in the prosecution of a claim for pension by said Chubb
