

Harlem May 10th 1890

Dear General: I was very much disappointed and surprised when I received your letter of the 13th ult. disappointed in not receiving the affidavit and surprised that your recollection was so at fault, for there was not an officer in the Regt that I was with more closely from the time we entered service up to my resignation than with yourself we were together when captured together during our imprisonment come to ~~Columbus~~ Columbus together where you were married went to our homes together returned to the Regt. together was in battle together when I was wounded was with you after the battle consulted with you in regard to my ailments and credits and by your advice sent in my resignation said resignation was written by you and based upon the very reasons as stated in the affidavit viz. Chronic diarrhoea piles and removal and general disability for which I was examined by the surgeons of the different grades and was discharged on those grounds. I have not seen a comrade of our Regt. since I left the service excepting

agt. Albert (now Judge) Deckermon, whom
I saw two or three years ago then only
for a short time. I sent him an affidavit
similar to the one I sent to you with the differ-
-ence he was not with me when taken prisoner
neither was he with the regt when I was wounded
he was home on recruiting service and returned
to the regt about a week after the battle, he exe-
-cuted the affidavit and returned to me. Said
affidavit covers every thing that is in the one
I sent to you excepting being with me when
taken prisoner - and in battle when wounded
although ~~he~~ does aver that he knows I
was taken prisoner and was wounded.

Now if this refreshes your memory so you can
do so I wish you would execute the affidavit
and send it to me at once, if you can not
execute it return it to me and I will try
and find some other comrad although I do not
know where to find a single one.
