Under date of May 5th, 1890, a notice was sent to each Policy-holder of a special meeting of the members of The National Alliance, to be held on Thursday, June 5th, at 3.30 P. Members holding receipts of The National Alliance for the payment of the June premium will receive the policy of the Commercial Alliance Life Insurance Company as soon after July 1st, 1890, as they can be prepared.

The Officers of The National Alliance congratulate the members on the additional strength secured by this union of the assets and interests of two well known companies.
