Yours with draft for \$65.<sup>00</sup> received. Many thanks for the same. We had about 8 or ten engagements for the judge in the West last season, but it was impossible to arrange the dates so there would have been some money in them for the judge, that is, they could not be made to come consecutive and rather than bring him here and have him lay idle for two or three days at a time, I concluded not to take him West at all.

We have two or three applications for him for this season, but I dare not offer him at less than \$75.<sup>00</sup> as it does not seem to pay below that sum.

I think 10% commissions on last year's work will be allright. I will look up the ~~money~~ as soon as I can get an hour or two to do it. I am engaged on jury service and have not had time to look over the books for the last two weeks.
