Dear Judge,

In my haste, in my
hurry to Carlewood, I forgot that the

trunk of it is going on all the time &
very largely so in New York City. Perhaps
a greater extent than in any of the
other large cities, as Tammany carries more
for the city patronage than for all other interests
combined, in fact she carries for nothing else.
