I think of manufacturing for general
use. w cheap bruchings to be sold to the trade
at 9^{cts}, 10^{cts} and 12^{cts} per dozen, if at
all feasible. I have application for a patent
for my invention. Yours was discovered. Though
my solicitors think they can patent same,
I will just as soon manufacture and stamp
as made under the "Fonger" patent and pay a
light royalty to you

I will not at first go largely
into it, but feel my way along and possibly
build up a trade of consequence. I trust
you will name equitable terms promptly and

Dear Sir:

I will give you a shopright to manufacture and sell to the trade under proper restrictions as to accounting, &c, on either of the following terms -

- 1 - For one year, only, fifty cents ^{royalty} for each dozen sold.
- 2 - For five years, yearly accounts -
dozen sold
For the first 1,000 ~~per annum~~ ^{per year}
\$1.00 per dozen royalty; for
the second 1,000, dozen ^{per year} \$1.75 -
per dozen royalty; for the
third 1,000, in each year
and for all over that num-
ber \$1.50 per dozen royalty.

The breaching can be made for 25 cts each - perhaps for less.

Disagreement among parties who were to engage in the manu-
facture of my business, but for delayed
work on it and becoming engaged in
other affairs nothing more has been
done with it. Except a set of experi-
mental harness somewhat worn
now in my possession there is
~~nothing~~ ^{nothing} are no samples of
it. The breaching is light double
double. You should also manufacture
the girth which is of the same construction.
