Dear Mrs. Torgue:

Your esteemed favor received. I am sorry as you can be that there should be any misunderstanding, as we regret very much that Judge Torgue's name is not on our enclosure list for the present year. We have so enlarged our facilities that certainly we can do more now for a lecturer twice over than we could a year ago. The season now is far advanced and you must not expect from us very much this year for that reason. We are ready to begin over again for the season of 1891-92 if it should be agreeable and take full charge of the Judge's business and work it for all there is in it. We are establishing state agencies in order that our business

may be more thoroughly worked, each state agent makes a canvass of their own territory in person.

We have disposed of Ohio, Penn. Vermont, Baltimore, Phila. Pacific coast, Mass. and Conn. and are negotiating for state agents in nearly all of the states for next season.
