I received Mr. Callaway's  
the Bytander of the Chicago Inter Ocean  
with interest I read the Bytanders notes also the  
criticisms he presented me of late concerning remarks I  
wrote as to the plausibility of colonizing the Negro  
As to his white blood he possessed it adds no merit to  
his white associations in Mo. as far as I have witnessed  
no exaltations among the blacks, he looked upon as an in-  
ferior. As to his 250 years of servitude & Hell dom in  
U.S. It looks to me as if he is a having a continuation of the  
same & with more severance than ever even during his slavery he  
was a mere pitance his rights as a citizen politically is dictated to  
him I shant hire you if you go with the black Republicans the best  
thing you can do Mr black man is to stay at home this is a white  
mans Government Negroes & Republicans in the south cant & shant  
rule us as long as there is any virtue in shotguns revolvers traps or  
any other way of controlling them having state rule & the whole politi-  
cal machinery in their hands Their declarations are this is a white mans  
Government & Democratic at that Mills of Texas stated that by no hook cross  
or shenanigan had the Republicans & Negroes been able to control their  
elections in the south & they need not in Mo. No doubt but what Mo. untroubled  
is Republican or at least Protectionist & opposed to unlimited silver coinage

The idea of not being possible to colonize the Negroes the interests they have  
shown at the mere hint of their colonization getting out of the south the vacant  
lands in Africa in other parts of the world The unrestricted emigration  
throughout the world Ireland as poor as she was during one year of Daniel  
out of 8,000,000 over 2,000,000 emigrated to other countries U.S.  
with her almost unlimited resources it looks to me ought to be able to aid as much  
the poor Negro. It has seemed strange to me that U.S. is so reacting of other  
nations & failing to have power in protecting her own citizens especially political  
This Government looks more like Alagars rule than Republics America  
that Congress has no rules this winter but controlled by Rufus Bice Hill  
& former I'm the south culture & habit has made the rule more formidable  
or in short the south dont mean to accept no rule but the pleasure of the Alagars  
which is war to the kill against Negro domination I doubt if the Alagars  
& whisky uncrapt will destroy the spirit so far it surely has failed  
Let me not claim to be a dictator for as the Negro has been unjustly  
enslaved in the U.S. & held in a country that wont treat out of him  
justly why still retain him if it can be avoided
