The Book of Mormon was written
in French, (then New Salem) by a
Congregational Minister named Phelps
claiming as a literary skit. It was sent
to a publishing firm in Philadelphia for
which Rigden worked. This was the
foundation of the fraudulent move-
ment afterwards converted by
LE LIVRE DE MORMON.

Smith and Rigden made the
basis of Mormonism. I have
had conversation with more
than one who had heard the
manuscript read, all con-
firming its substantial
identity with the Book of
Mormon.
