

Certainly if we keep the market supplied with the books, there should be no reason why after we have advertised and work up a sale for the books to the fullest extent, that at the end of five years the books should be taken away from us, nolens volens. We think you will see the fairness of our position and have no hesitation in accepting the modification in this respect. All of our statements are made the first of each year. The majority of books are sold in the summer, bills payable in January, and for us to render an account in August and pay for books sold where the accounts run until January would not be just to ourselves, besides being a matter of great inconvenience
