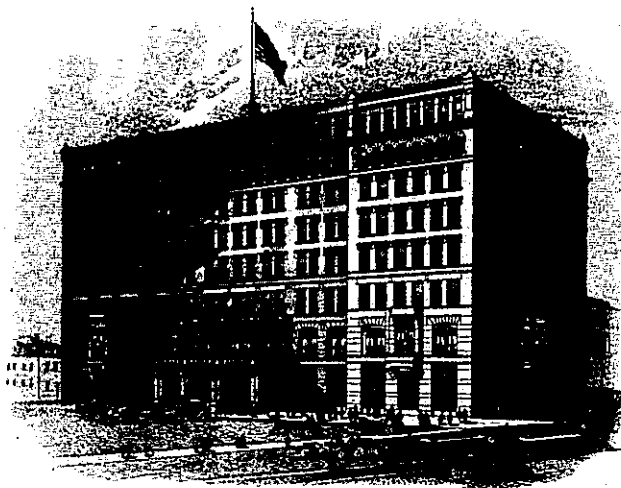


ABSOLUTELY FIRE PROOF
