Dear Madam:-

Your favor of the 21st., enclosing correspondence with Levy regarding the size of title page, etc., is just received. The writer is not informed correctly as to what size page was exactly decided upon. By reference to a letter sent to you March 9th., I find that Mr. Merrill told you that the type page would be 3-1/2 x 6 inches. Another letter to you dated March 14th. speaks of having mailed some sample pages, and contains the information that he (Mr. Merrill) did not like them and that the revised page would be 1/8 of an inch narrower and one line shorter. I find no reference in any of the letters about making the type page 3-5/8 inches. Unfortunately Mr. Merrill, who has had this matter in hand, is in St. Paul, and I am not certain as to the date of his return; he will be here at any rate by the first of May, this I am sure of. In his absence I have given you all the information available from this office. I am not certain as to whether mail sent to Mr. Merrill at St. Paul will reach him before he starts East again, but I will write him to-night and take the chances. In the meantime upon investigating the matter more closely you may find out positively just which size was determined upon.
