Dear Sir:—

Referring to my communication to you of the 17th ult., in which you were requested to name ten delegates to represent your State at the Interstate Coal Combination and other Unlawful Trusts Conference, to be held on the first Monday in June next, at such place as would be mutually satisfactory to the Governors of the different States and Territories, I have the honor to inform you that favorable responses have been received from a large majority of the Governors, who signify their intention of appointing delegates to attend this Conference.

It is evidently the wish of a majority of the Governors that the Conference be held at Chicago, as a larger and more representative gathering can be had and the States will be more fully and generally represented. In view of this fact, the Conference will be held at Central Music Hall in the city of Chicago, on the 5th and 6th days of June, 1893, commencing at ten o'clock A. M, on June 5th.

Indications point to a large gathering of representative men from the different States in the Union, and I sincerely hope your State will be fully represented at that time. Kindly furnish me with the names and addresses of the persons whom you appoint. I am,
