Gentlemen:

I want the following in seamless brass tubing very stiff and bright:

1 - ^{eight} Four pieces 6 inches long - ~~8 ft long~~, one inch outside diameter and about #18 W.G. in thickness

2 - pieces 6 ft long, about the same quality and thickness to fit exactly over the other. This wants to be a close fit so as not to allow motion but not close enough so that it cannot be removed without difficulty.

4 - Four pieces 6 inches long

about the same quality
of tubing of a size to fit
smoothly and run easily
along the last above
described pieces. These
are intended as guides and
should move freely over
the enclosed tube to avoid
friction.

The thickness of these
tubes is not very material
as there will be little lateral
strain in their use. I should
say from #18 to No #22 or perhaps
#24 would do. But the fitting
is essential as described.

Please let me know Respectfully,
