Hon A. R. Jones, - Mayfield Miss  
My Dr "Boys & Men"

A Citizen of Mississippi  
was most ruthlessly lynched, hung, ket-  
led and murdered, by a Mob of Illi-  
noisians at Decatur, 25 miles east of  
Springfield Friday morning last about 2 o-  
clock; such Citizen was in the custody  
of the law-in jail under the protection  
of the great State of Illinois when the  
jail was forced and such American Citizen  
of the State of Mississippi was taken out  
and violently and forcibly down to  
death;

"And then you and I and all of us  
"Told damn, and Blatantly transgressed"

of the American Citizens, <sup>Constitution</sup> ought to be
