We are in receipt of your favor of July 8th and in regard to Cow-peas would state they are not usually grown north of Virginia as they require a longer season than we have to develop. We think that the Canada Field Peas would better suit your purpose and be more certain of giving a good return. These are used generally by the farmers in this section and northwards. We can furnish them at \$2.00 per bushel or \$1.85 per bushel in ten-bushel lots. We can also furnish Cow-peas at \$3.00 per bus. or in 10 bus. lots at \$2.85 per bushel.
