Of course, I am quite anxious to know how the things reach you, and will be pleased to have you write to me concerning them, addressing your letter to me at Jorosa, Las Animas Co. Colo. It seemed quite difficult to

get such things as I wanted, and I failed
to get many of them.

I yet hope to get a blanket, and belt,
and a ceremonial scarf; and will send
them to you should I ever get them.
