I will see if I can find one for  
you I am living over the same  
place that got from you and  
have been getting along very  
well but times is getting hard  
down here know Judge you would  
not know the place that I got  
from you I have got good size  
meat over over it & a carload  
Rosa & Laura ship some  
so plenty of fruit this year  
& Violet on ship of salt you  
some but ship not know was  
to send it we have not heard  
from you in a long time I  
know Rosa & the children are  
all well we have ten children  
living Pattie Duff she died  
January 19 1891.
