#### CHARGES FOR EXCURSIONS AND DRIVES.

If possible, orders for Excursion Wagons should be left at the office half a day in advance. Covered Excursion Wagons can be had to carry two, three, five, seven and nine persons with two on a seat besides the driver. Parties wishing to drive themselves can secure Buggies, Buckboards or Surreys by giving notice at the office.

As charges for parties going with a driver are made for the distance and not by the hour, drivers are instructed to go slowly, giving all the opportunity possible to see each point of interest. If greater speed be desired, drivers should be so informed.

The charge for Buggies and Buckboards carrying two persons is \$1.50 for the first hour and \$1.00 for each additional hour for drives on the estate. The charge for Teams and Surreys, without driver, is \$3 for the first hour and \$2 for each additional hour.

For drives down the mountains special rates will be made at the office.

For schedule charges, see other side.

For rates of Stage Fare see printed time tables.

For a full description of these and other drives and paths, see Illustrated Guide of Mohonk.

MINNEWASKA.—The distance to Minnewaska is 7½ miles, over a road shady a large part of the way. The time from Mohonk to Minnewaska is 2½ hours, and return time 2½ hours. If desired, the driver will take the party around Minnewaska Lake, visiting both the Cliff House and the Wildmere. Parties wishing to spend the day at Minnewaska, usually start 9:30 to 10 A. M., and return in season for tea. The charge for dinner at Minnewaska is \$1 for each person, and \$1 for the driver and horses, to be paid there.

ROCK RIFT ROAD, taken with Copes' Lookout, Bridge Road, Huguenot Drive and Pine Hill, makes a very cool and pleasant drive, which may be easily extended to Prospect Drive or Guyot's Hill, and in various other directions.

GULF ROAD—Distance, 5½ miles; including Huguenot and North Lookout or Forest Drive, makes a very pleasant drive for the afternoon, it being shaded most of the way. Two miles of this road is absolutely level, and overlooks a beautiful little valley which extends up into the mountain. When taken with Huguenot and North Lookout Drives, parties can obtain good views of both the Walkill and the Rondout Valleys.

GUYOT'S HILL and Huguenot Heights is the finest drive on the estate, and includes Lake Shore and Forest Drives, Bridge Road, Prospect and Pine water Drives, returning by Bonticue Road or by a short circuit beyond Guyot's Hill and by Huguenot Drive

CEDAR DRIVE is a long and very beautiful drive, extending beyond Guyot's Hill through pastures, meadows and farm lands, past Bonticue Crag, Clearwater Cottage and Spring Farm, returning by Huguenot Drive and North Lookout.

MOSSY BROOK—This drive is down the west side of the mountain, through forest for rather more than a mile, to the hemlock-shaded rocks that line the bed of Mossy Brook, which it crosses, and a mile beyond reaches the public road near the Clove Chapel. Returning by Huguenot and North Lookout or Prospect Drives.

ROSENDALE.—Drive down Mossy Brook Road and through the Rondout Valley, returning by Huguenot Drive or farms. The Gement Quarries and Tunnels are points of interest worth visiting. This is the region that furnishes all the Rosendale Cement in the market.

TRAPPS' DRIVE—This road is quite steep in some places, but a fine drive along the east base of the Trapps' Mountain, crossing through the Notch, and returning by the Minnewaska Road.

COXING CLOVE is a pleasant drive through the Clove along the Coxing Kill, including a part of the Minnewaska Drive and Mossy Brook Road.

HIGH FALLS AND ALLIGERVILLE—This Drive is along the Delaware and Hudson Canal. The Falls of the Rondout Creek and the Cement Works are points of interest.

Mohonk Lake is located near the summit of Sky-Top, one of the higher of the Shawangunk Mountains, in Ulster County, New York, ninety miles from New York City, and is about sixteen miles west of Poughkeepsie on the Hudson River; fifteen miles west of Highland on the West Shore R. R., ten miles west of Loyd on the C. N. E. & W. R. R. (Poughkeepsie Bridge Route) and six miles west of New Paltz, a station on the Wallkill Valley R. R., which connects with the West Shore at Kingston, with the N. Y., Ont. & West'n at Campbell Hall, and with the Erie at Montgomery and Goshen.

From all the principal stations on the West Shore, New York, Ontario & Western, Erie and Pennsylvania Railroads, tickets are sold and baggage checked through to Mohonk House. There is also a Ticket Office in Mohonk House, where tickets are sold and baggage checked. Stage tickets do not include charge for baggage (see table below). Persons having stage tickets should kindly hand them in at the office on their arrival at Mohonk House, as the drivers of the stages do not collect stage fares. Rates of fare (including stage) are as follows:
