Am very glad to hear of continued ill-
ness of your daughter.

Have rented the room un-
til the 19th inst. so there is
no expense to you in the
matter.

Our streets are swarmed
with people seeking rooms.
I turned away a dozen
or so today at our door whom
I could not entertain or
secure places for outside.

There are now only 3 days on
your engagement at my house
viz for 19th, 20th & 21st inst.

On the 22nd the room is engaged
by another party who has paid
