Dear Sir :

Yours of the 25th received. We have never had combination to this safe, as it was delivered direct to you by Mr. Flagler, with the safe. We are therefore unable to offer any suggestions about the operation of the deal. Is it not possible that you have made a mistake in one of the numbers, or that you did not turn the required number of times to each number? Look this up carefully, then operate the lock, working the dial slowly and carefully each way, bringing it up squarely on the numbers; then let it stand on the last number, and place a book or a flat piece of wood on the door directly over the dial and hammer on it a few times. If the dog sticks from any cause whatever, this will have a tendency to jar it sufficiently to let it drop into the tumblers. Then by turning it the right direction it should bring it to a full stop and unlock the safe. Should it be necessary to drill the safe, then we can save you the expense of a man from Buffalo, as one of your local machinists could drill the door by following the enclosed instructions. The door could then be taken off and shipped here for repairs and a new lock, which we will make to you under the circumstances, at \$15.00.
