

Know Ye, that the bearer hereof,

Alphonse W. Tourgee, a citizen of the United States,
Consul of the United States at Bordeaux, France, is about
to proceed to his post.

These are therefore to request all whom it may
concern to permit him to pass freely without let or molestation, and to
extend to him all such friendly aid and protection, as would
be extended to like officers ~~employed~~ of Foreign Governments
resorting to the United States.

In testimony whereof, I, William R. Day, Acting
Secretary of State of the United States of America,
have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of
the Department of State to be affixed at Washington,
this 10th day of June A.D. 1897 and of the
Independence of the United States of America,
the 12th William R. Day.
