Dear Mrs. Tourgee,

This is the first opportunity I have had this week to send you the statement of amount due on your bond and mortgage.

I find that the last payment was made in June last, and that I wrote you June 3d, stating that the balance due was \$784.69 with interest paid to June 16th. The interest upon that amount to Nov. 16th, five months at 4%, is \$13.08, making the amount now due \$797.76, for which I have filled and enclose a check on our bank here, which please sign and return to me, and I will discharge the mortgage, and send you all the papers.

You may remember that some years ago, you said there was a special matter for which you had to have \$102, and asked me if I would let you have it. I did so, and you gave me your note for the amount. Do you wish to pay that note now? If so, I will send you a statement of the amount due.

The Arcanum draft was deposited by me in The National Bank of Westfield, and you have undoubtedly received their acknowledgment of it. I enclose a few blank checks which you may want to use.
